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## REVIEW OF LOCALISM SCHEMES 2009/10 AND THE LIST OF SCHEMES FOR CONSIDERATION FOR 2010/11

### 1 SUMMARY

- 1.1 This report gives an opportunity for Members to review the progress of schemes selected for implementation during 2009/10, as shown in section 1 of appendix A, and to consider which schemes, as shown in section 2 of appendix A will be progressed during 2010/11.

### 2 INTRODUCTION

- 2.1 Localism introduced at the beginning of this financial year has given local people, through their elected Members, an opportunity to influence improvements and changes to the highway within the Rochford District in line with policy and guidelines from Essex County Council. The reserve programme schemes that were previously suggested through the Locally Determined Programme and were not selected for implementation this year have been added to throughout the year with new suggestions and requests under Localism. The list made available in this report is for Members to decide on which schemes will be put forward for implementation this coming financial year and to identify the priority of those schemes within the West Area only.

### 3 RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 Although budgets for 2010/11 have not yet been agreed by Essex County Council, Members should consider working to a sum similar to that allocated this financial year, which was in the region of £200,000.

### 4 RECOMMENDATION

- 4.1 It is proposed that the Committee recommends a list of schemes with priorities for delivery by Essex County Council during 2010/11.
