1 TOURISM STUDY – A SUGGESTED WAY FORWARD

- 1.1 This item of business was referred by the Community Overview & Scrutiny Committee on 11 May to Council with the recommendation that a tourism study, as outlined in the report, be funded from the 2004/05 Budget allocation. A copy of the officer's report is appended.
- 1.2 Members had agreed that the consultant should be asked to identify the top six priorities. This should include suggestions around funding opportunities.
- 1.3 Actions endorsed by Members would be fed into the budget process in the autumn.
- 1.4 Members made a number of suggestions around improving tourism within the District as follows:-
 - Better signage.
 - Improved advertising using leaflets.
 - Work in conjunction with other districts and bodies, particularly Thames Gateway and local Tourist offices.
 - Emphasise our heritage.
 - Provide information around facilities available close to tourist sites, such as food outlets and car parking.
 - Provision of heritage/town walk leaflets.

1.5 It is proposed that Council **RESOLVES**

That a tourism study, as outlined in the report, be funded from the 2004/05 Budget allocation. (CE)
