H6	<p>Amend last line of second paragraph to:</p> <p><i>In the case of developments comprising between 10 and 30 dwellings, at least one dwelling will be expected to be built to full wheelchair accessibility standards.</i></p>
6.15	<p>Amend second sentence to:</p> <p><i>Large scale equestrian facilities, however, are not considered an appropriate form of green tourism because they have the potential to significantly impact on the openness and character of the Green Belt.</i></p>
8.15	<p>Amend first sentence: delete first reference to <i>both</i></p>
ENV10	<p>Amend to:</p> <p><i>The Council will require new non-residential buildings, as a minimum, to meet the BREEAM rating of 'Very Good', unless such requirements would render a particular development economically unviable. In cases where it is considered appropriate to relax the requirement to meet the BREEAM rating of 'Very Good' due to viability issues, the Council will still expect development to meet as high a BREEAM rating as is economically viable. The Eco-Enterprise Centre proposed for the District will meet the 'Excellent' rating.</i></p>
8.45	<p>Amend end of first sentence to:</p> <p><i>came into force on 1st April 2000.</i></p>
CLT7	<p>Amend second paragraph to:</p> <p><i>Play space within developments should be maintained by an appropriate management company.</i></p>
9.46	<p>Amend final sentence to:</p> <p><i>Within the Green Belt, the minimum size recommended by the guidance for accompanying facilities must not be exceeded.</i></p>
