SUBJECT: DEVELOPMENT OF EVENTS IN THE ROCHFORD DISTRICT

1 DECISION BEING RECOMMENDED

1.1 To note the content of the report providing an update on the development of events in the Rochford District.

2 REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 The District has a number of untapped natural assets that could be used in innovative ways to increase tourism and ultimately generate revenue for the Council by developing a sustainable programme of large and smaller scale events, building on the current offer that residents and visitors value and that generates revenue for the Council.
- 2.2 Events can bring significant numbers of visitors to the area and encourage residents to explore their local area rather than travel outside of the District. Building on the events offer will encourage this further and raise the profile of the District, generate direct revenue for the Council and also generate revenue for local businesses through increased footfall.

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The current events calendar has been researched and collated, with events listed month by month and separated into Rochford District, Southend and surrounding areas (Appendix 1). The analysis shows a good range of existing events in the District and surrounding areas, with a large number of events held in Southend. There is scope to investigate developing certain existing events or developing new events to meet any gaps in provision identified through the events calendar.
- 3.2 Existing events such as Wild Woods day attract approximately 2,000-3,000 visitors and the Rayleigh Christmas light event attracts approximately 4,000. The largest events held in the District over the last two years have been the Olympic Torch Relay (approx. 30,000) and Armed Forces Day, Rayleigh (approx. 10,000).

4 POTENTIAL DELIVERY MODELS

4.1 In-house - the Leisure Team currently deliver several events of varying size across the District. The existing programme of events (and other work streams) would need to be looked at to enable more large scale events to be delivered by the Leisure Team.

- 4.2 Community Groups a large number of existing voluntary groups currently deliver various events in the community, although mostly smaller in scale.
- 4.4 Private Sector events companies successfully run several large scale events in surrounding Local Authority areas for which they are charged for the hire of Council owned public spaces.
- 4.5 In reality, a combination of the above would be considered to be the best way forward to achieve the stated outcomes. This could include developing and promoting existing smaller scale events in parallel with developing and growing large scale events.
- 4.7 The Events On-line Calendars will be developed to promote all events across the District and placed in a high profile position on the RDC website in order to maximise the financial benefit to the Council and take up of the events.
- 4.8 The development of a broader range of events was discussed at the recent Business Summit where local businesses were very much in support of the approach and keen to be involved, where possible.

5 POTENTIAL PARTNERS

5.1 In broadening the range of events taking place in the district there could be a range of potential partners including Aztec Events, RSPB, Chambers of Trade, Rayleigh Town Team. Other links with promoters and events companies should be explored and developed. Aztec Events are a local events company based in Rochford, delivering a large number of major events across the East Region.

6 ANALYSIS OF POTENTIAL VENUES

6.2 Considering the above, it is considered that Cherry Orchard Country Park is the best suited Council facility to host these types of large scale events. However, the other venues listed above are also being considered as venues for staging smaller events.

7 BUSINESS MODEL FOR INITIAL LARGE SCALE EVENT

- 7.1 Aztec events have been approached with a view to running a Country Show style event on August Bank Holiday weekend 2015. Aztec believes Cherry Orchard Jubilee Country Park has potential to be an effective site for this type of large scale event, although they also noted the issues as raised above.
- 7.2 It is proposed that subject to obtaining the necessary licence, that Aztec pay RDC £1,500 in Year 1 (2015) to run the event. Aztec would be solely responsible for the event, including; infrastructure, promotion and marketing and ticket sales etc. Their business model would not include a share of the ticket sales for the Council for this first event. Aztec could not run an event in 2014 (even if the hire fee was waived) due to other commitments and their desire to carry out the necessary planning, market research and promotion. The hire fee would be negotiated in future years in relation to the success of the event, and could include the potential share of ticket sales.
- 7.3 Investment by the Council into the site's infrastructure including toilets and water standpipes would reduce the overheads of the event company and may escalate the speed of development of the event offer and the subsequent income generated, although Aztec have indicated that they would still run the event without this infrastructure being in place.

8 OTHER LARGE SCALE EVENTS

8.1 Scoping work is also being carried out into the viability and delivery models of other large scale events at Cherry Orchard Country Park (and other venues across the District). These include music festivals, open air theatre, events at Wallasea and sports events. These projects will require further work to develop a sound business case and to identify the appropriate resources and delivery models to deliver the required outcomes.

9 RISK IMPLICATIONS

9.1 The delivery of events by a private sector partner removes the financial risk from the Authority should the event fail to generate the expected revenue.

- However the Council's control of the quality or type of the event is also reduced to a certain extent through this approach.
- 9.2 Whilst there are prospects for a permanent highway access to be secured through the JAAP, the current highway access has only temporary consent and expires early next year. A condition is imposed on the original planning consent for the change of use (ref. 07/00652/DP3) agreed in 2007 for the construction of a ghosted right hand turn from Cherry Orchard Way. There is therefore a risk that objections could be raised in respect of licensing applications for large scale events due to highway safety issues.

10 RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

10.1 The installation of standpipes and highway access to Cherry Orchard County Park should be investigated as this additional infrastructure would assist the site to develop as an attraction venue for events companies to hire. A business case will be submitted to the Executive for approval before any capital or revenue expenditure is committed.
