
BULKHEAD LIGHTING – ROCHFORD TOWN CENTRE IMPROVEMENTS

1 SUMMARY

- 1.1 To seek Members' approval for funds to be made available from the crime and disorder reduction strategy budget for bulkhead lighting in Rochford Town Centre.

2 INTRODUCTION

- 2.2 The Rochford Town Centre Working Group met on 5 November 2001 and discussed the issue of street lighting. Copies of a proposed street lighting layout for Market Square, which had been drawn up by Websters, the lighting engineers, were distributed to the Working Group for consideration.
- 2.3 The Working Group expressed concern about a lack of lighting alongside the alley next to Barclays Bank and agreed that a report should go to the Community Services Committee requesting funding under the crime and disorder reduction strategy budget.

3 CRIME AND DISORDER IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 As detailed in the strategy.

4 RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 At this early stage, exact costing for the initiative are unavailable but for the installation of two bulkhead lights the cost will be approximately £2000.
- 4.2 There will also be a standard rolling cost for the power supply.

5 RECOMMENDATION

- 5.1 It is proposed that the Committee **RESOLVES**
- 2.4 To agree that £2000 be made available under the crime and disorder reduction strategy budget for bulkhead lighting alongside the alley next to Barclays Bank, to be organised through the Working Group and appointed lighting engineers.
