290 HACKNEY CARRIAGE DRIVER'S LICENCE

The Committee considered the exempt report of the Head of Planning and Transportation relating to a breach of a condition of a hackney carriage driver's licence in respect of a driver's conviction for a criminal offence.

The Committee considered that the driver's conviction and his failure to report the conviction to the Transportation Manager was in direct breach of the Council's licensing conditions. It was, however, deemed that the driver's previous good character should be taken into consideration.

The Committee, having considered all the evidence, felt it appropriate to issue the driver with a formal warning that any further offence or unacceptable conduct would be referred to the Committee. The Committee also deemed that the driver should be required to report on his conduct to the Transportation Manager once a week for a period of four weeks.

- (1) That the driver be required to report on his conduct to the Transportation Manager once a week for a period of 4 weeks.
- (2) That the driver be issued with a formal warning that any further offence or unacceptable conduct would result in the matter being referred to the Committee. (HPT)
