# TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AND INFORMATION TRAINING SESSION

#### 1 SUMMARY

1.1. This report seeks Member nominations to attend a Traffic Management Information and Training session on 25 May 2000.

This is a discretionary activity, though the aims of the session are linked to the initiatives that will be implemented through the statutory Local Transport Plan and the district transport strategy.

#### 2 TRAINING SESSION ARRANGEMENTS

- 2.1 At the County Council's Highways and Transportation committee meeting on 16 March 2000, Members recommended that a training session be organised to provide councillors with more information on topics related to the school journey.
- 2.2 The session has been arranged for Thursday 25 May in the Council Chamber at County Hall between 9 am and 13.00 pm. A buffet lunch will be provided.
- 2.3 At this stage, it is proposed that the programme will cover:
  - Safer journeys to school
  - 20 mph speed limits
  - speed camera enforcement
- 2.4 The session has been arranged to enable three representatives from each authority to attend. It is suggested that the Chairs of Transportation and Environmental Services and Transportation Sub-Committee or their nominees attend the meeting, together with an officer.

#### 4 CRIME AND DISORDER IMPLICATIONS

4.1 The training session will cover issues related to speeding within the vicinity of schools.
