Mobile Breast Screening Unit In Mill Hall Car Park (Minute 221/04)	That the mobile breast screening unit be allowed to locate at the rear of Mill Hall, that the NHS Trust be charged £1824 for loss of revenue and two season tickets and that the NHS Trust be charged for the cost of moving the lamp column. (HRHM)
High Hedges – Consultation (Minute 222/04)	That the Council's response to the consultation be on the basis set out in the officers' report, subject to the following Member comments:-
	<ul> <li>The costs of the scheme should not be funded by the revenue support grant.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The maximum fee per case should be £450.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Additional resources should be made available to enable the Council to charge reduced costs to those on low incomes.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The costs to the Council associated with any appeals should be reimbursed centrally.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Offenders should also be liable for costs. (CD(F&amp;ES))</li> </ul>
