

## NOTICE OF POLICY DECISIONS

The Environmental Services Committee made the following decisions at its meeting on 7 June 2005:-

<u>Item</u>	<u>Decision</u>
<b>Downhall Road Rayleigh Proposed Installation of Pedestrian Crossing</b> (Minute 220/05)	That the zebra crossing be installed in the location as shown on Appendix A to the report. (County Highways)
<b>Changes to the Development Control System – Second Consultation Paper</b> (Minute 221/05)	That, subject to the following amendments, this report forms the basis of the Council's response to the Second Consultation Paper on Changes to the Development Control System: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Delete the first two sentences of paragraph 3.4.</li><li>• Paragraph 3.8 to be re-worded, as follows:- "There would need to be extreme caution exercised with respect to the principle of LDOs, and their use would need to be carefully considered as an option during the preparation of Development Plan Documents." (HPS)</li></ul>
<b>Formation of a Groundwork Trust for the Thames Gateway South East Area</b> (Minute 222/05)	That the creation of a Groundwork Trust for the Thames Gateway South Essex Area be supported and that this Council contributes up to £10,000 per annum, either in cash or kind, from 2006/7, index linked for a period of six years. (CD(F&ES))

The above decisions will come into force, and may then be implemented, on the expiry of five working days after the publication of this Notice, unless referred to Full Council by a minimum of 3 Members or called in by an Overview and Scrutiny Committee.
