## 393 HACKNEY CARRIAGE VEHICLE LICENCE

The Committee considered the exempt report of the Head of Planning and Transportation detailing breaches of the hackney carriage vehicle licence in respect of a failure by a driver to provide proof of continuous insurance cover for his vehicle and using the hackney carriage vehicle for hire and reward without insurance cover.

The Committee viewed the driver's failure to comply with the licensing conditions in a serious light and considered that he had behaved irresponsibly, particularly given his experience as a licensed taxi driver.

However, given the driver's previous good record and co-operative behaviour, the Committee had decided not to revoke the vehicle licence. Taking into account the driver's personal circumstances the Committee was of the view that the driver's hackney carriage vehicle licence should be suspended for a period of three months. The Committee warned the driver that his hackney carriage vehicle licence would be at risk of revocation in the event of a repetition of these offences.

## Resolved

(1)	That the hackney carriage vehicle licence be suspended for three
	months.

(2) That the driver be issued with a formal warning that any further breaches in the licensing conditions could result in the revocation of the hackney carriage vehicle licence. (HPT)
