6 REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

Council considered the report of the Assistant Director – Democratic Services, which sought agreement of the final proposals of the review of all Polling Districts and Polling Places, following the conclusion of the Electoral Review of Rochford District Council.

In response to Member questions, the following was noted:-

- If a circumstance arises where there is not a polling station identified within the boundaries of a polling district, proposals envisaged that the polling place can be extended to enable a polling station in a polling district bordering the area in question to be used.

- The possibility of using temporary buildings as polling stations to enable there to be a polling station situated within the particular polling place is included in considerations when polling stations are reviewed. Any temporary accommodation used would have to be Disability Discrimination Act compliant.

Resolved

- (1) That each polling district and the polling districts bordering it be designated as the polling place for that polling district.
- (2) That the final arrangements for polling districts, as set out in the Appendix to the report, be endorsed.
