Item D1 - 05/00237/ADV - 3-15 South Street, Rochford

Proposal – Externally illuminated sign and non illuminated directional sign and coat of arms located at open archway to front of building.

Proposal – Revised application for: Block A: two and three storey building containing supermarket, library, 3 no. shops, 42 no. flats (24 two-bedroomed and 18 one-bedroomed) and involving re-siting, revised car parking layout; Block B: two and three storey building containing 34 no. sheltered flats (17 two-bedroomed and 17 one-bedroomed) and 3 no. shops and involving revised elevations and revised car parking layout; Block C: two, three and four storey building containing 73 no. flats (44 two-bedroomed and 29 one-bedroomed) and involving revised elevations, revised car parking layout, increase in height by 0.6m to building previously approved, provision of sliding gate and provision of two electrical sub-stations and variation of condition 27 of consent 03/00947/FUL to allow revised layout of car parking area for the supermarket and revised arrangements for dedication of residents' car parking.

That this application be deferred to allow the applicants to consider and submit revised details to achieve a satisfactory turning head within the site to overcome concerns expressed by the Highways Authority. (HPS)
