HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE PROGRAMME 2000/2001

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

To appraise Members of the allocation of funds for the maintenance of highways in the Rochford District Council area for 2000/2001, together with the approved Special Maintenance budget.

2. BASIC MAINTENANCE

This comprises the small scale structural maintenance work such as the routine patching of footways and carriageways, where the cost of any individual scheme is below £3,000. It also includes safety, environmental and winter maintenance works.

The allocations for 2000/2001 are set out below, together with the 1999/2000 allocation shown in brackets.

SPECIAL MAINTENANCE		
This comprises the larger reconstruction and resurfacing schemes for both footways and carriageways. This allocation is made on a need basis. Areas most in need of attention are determined by inspection then surveyed and ranked on a county wide basis.

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4. SURFACE DRESSING

This consists of the provision of a thin surface treatment to waterproof the existing road structure, to provide a new surface with an improved skid resistance and texture depth to reduce surface water spray.

The total allocation for surface dressing in 2000/2001: £100,836 (£117,344)
