

CONSERVATION AND HERITAGE AWARDS 2004

1 SUMMARY

- 1.1 This report seeks Members' agreement with regard to the appointment of a Member Panel to judge the entries to the Rochford Design, Heritage and Conservation Awards for 2004.

2 AWARD ARRANGEMENTS

- 2.1 Ten entries have been received for this year's awards, the closing date for which was 1 June 2004. As in previous years, it is proposed that Members nominate and authorise a small panel, of say five, to examine the entries and determine the recipients of awards.
- 2.2 It is anticipated that once judging has been completed, the Chairman of the Council will present the awards during the annual Heritage Open Day in September 2004
