# HIGHWAYS LOCAL SERVICE AGREEMENT QUARTERLY UPDATE REPORT: OCTOBER TO DECEMBER 2006

## 1 SUMMARY

1.1 This quarterly update report is to inform Members of Essex County Council (ECC) Highway and Transportation issues in the district in the period from October to December 2006. However, due to the timing, it also includes activities during January 2007.

### 2 BUDGETS FOR 2006/07

2.1 The allocated budgets were indicated in the Quarterly Report of April to June 2006. Spend is going well and progress on particular issues are discussed below.

## 3 THE LOCALLY DETERMINED BUDGET (LDB) 2006/07

3.1 Schemes within this budget were approved by this Committee on 15 July 2006. Below is an update of approved schemes to date.

## 5 PLANNED PARISH VISITS (PPV)

- 5.1 Rochford was this year allocated a specific budget for planned parish visits following on from previous successful years. Due to a fairly low interest from some parishes, the Area Office has identified various small scale schemes to spend the budget.
- 5.2 There is no specific allocation for PPVs in the 2007/08 budget.

## 6 DRAINAGE WORK

6.1 Additional budget was allocated for drainage investigations. Work to date has included camera work, cleaning and replacement of old pipes. We are working down an existing list of issues, together with new problems as they become apparent.

- 6.2 We have undertaken one complete cleanse of the district's gully pots and are currently mid way through a second cleanse.
- 6.3 It is intended to undertake 2 complete cleanses of gullies in 2007/08 with additional visits for known problem areas.
- 6.4 To assist in our gully cleanse operations, maintenance of the drainage system and overall public safety, it is requested that RDC undertake additional street sweeping operations in known areas of high detritus or following high winds when leaves, etc, are in the carriageway. Left unswept, this enters and blocks the drainage systems causing flooding and safety hazards.

## 7 PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY (PROW)

- 7.1 Work has continued from last year on the ECC 5 year rolling programme whereby 20% of the PRoW network is surveyed each year and any necessary work is undertaken.
- 7.2 The surveys for this year's 20% were in the areas of Canewdon, Ashingdon and Rayleigh.
- 7.3 The areas for survey next year (2007/08) are Foulness, Great Stambridge and Hullbridge.

### 8 FOOTWAY MAINTENANCE SCHEMES

- 8.1 We have undertaken and have nearly completed numerous footway schemes this year across the district.
- 8.2 These have been in Grove Road, Rayleigh, Plumberow Avenue, Hockley and Whitehall Road, Great Wakering. In addition, we are in the process of works to the footways in Alexandra Road, Lascelles Gardens, Albert Road, Stanley Road, Princess Gardens and York Road, all in Hawkwell, together with a section in Southend Road, Rochford fronting the shops.

## 9 THE ECC MAINTENANCE INITIATIVE IN ROCHFORD DISTRICT 2006/07

9.1 Rochford District was allocated around £900,000.00 for the delivery of the ECC Maintenance Initiative in 2006/07. A summary of progress to date is listed below.

10.1 On 4th November 2005, Cllr Bass agreed to the southern section schemes of the A130 Post Bypass Measures. The majority of the work was undertaken last year but we continued this year with the schemes below.

11.1 We have received funding to continue this year with the schemes listed below that were unable to be completed within the LTP1 timescale.

12.1 These schemes are made possible by receiving funding mainly from private developers.

Ashingdon Road junction with Brays Lane, Ashingdon – junction improvements to include removal of 'Bennett' style junction in favour of 'T' junction together with relocation of bus stops.	Redesign was undertaken due to local comments and cost of utility apparatus relocation. Planned utility apparatus relocation work during Easter school holidays followed by main scheme during school summer holidays. Follow on consultation to be undertaken.
Eastwood Rise and Rayleigh Avenue, Rayleigh – remedial works to achieve adoptable status – subject to residents' approval.	Residents' consultation / exhibition on 11 February. Site start anticipated early 2007.

#### Schemes for 2007/08

- 13.7 As we have only just received notification of budgets, we are currently determining what schemes are to be undertaken in accordance with our survey information and local knowledge. It is hoped the above budgets, particularly for the Highways Maintenance Initiative, are not final as there are many roads across the district that are in need of repair. We would gratefully receive any suggestions from Members for consideration.
- 13.8 The annual letter for Locally Determined Schemes has recently been sent to key stakeholders requesting suggestions for schemes from the 2007/08 budget. The letter also included the rolling programme of schemes requesting any updated information.
