COUNTY-WIDE HEALTH FORUM – A REQUEST FOR MEMBER NOMINATION

1 PURPOSE

1.1 To seek a Member nomination for an Essex-wide Health Forum to be set up under the auspices of the Association of Essex Councils.

2 DETAILED CONSIDERATIONS

- 2.1 The Association of Essex Councils (AEC) has agreed to the establishment of an Essex-wide Health Forum comprising representatives from District Councils, the County Council, the 2 Unitary Authorities, the 2 Health Authorities, the Essex Association of Local Councils, the Primary Care Groups and Health Trusts across the County, and the Police Authority. It is felt that the establishment of such a body will allow Members to consider matters relating to the wider health agenda and inequalities in health in their widest interpretation, across the County.
- 2.2 As a body the forum will provide a linkage between health issues and the wider agenda associated with such aspects as community safety and sustainable development. It is likely to meet between 2 and 4 times per year. In establishing such a forum the AEC have agreed to one Member representative from each District Council. A nomination is therefore sought for this body.

3 CRIME AND DISORDER IMPLICATIONS

3.1 Nothing specific although the purpose of the forum will be to consider the wider linkages between Crime and Disorder and health related issues.

4 ENVIRONMENTAL IMPLICATIONS

4.1 As with Crime and Disorder, the forum will consider health issues in the wider environmental context

5 FINANCIAL/RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

5.1 Nothing specific other than Member and Officer time and Mileage allowance

6 **LEGAL IMPLICATIONS**

The developing legislation is leading to closer working relationships 6.1 between local authorities and the health agencies.

7 **PARISH IMPLICATIONS**

7.1 The Essex Association of Local Council will be represented in its own right.
