

NOTICE OF POLICY DECISIONS

The Planning Policy and Transportation Committee made the following decisions at its meeting on 15 February 2007:-

<u>Item</u>	<u>Decision</u>
East of England Plan (Minute 36/07)	<p>(1) That the comments made by the East of England Regional Assembly relating to the proposed changes to the East of England Plan, together with the concerns outlined in the officer's report and a final statement to the effect that the Plan is not fit for purpose, should form the basis of this Council's response to the consultation on the proposed changes to the East of England Plan.</p> <p>(2) That a Policy Adviser from the Department of Communities and Local Government be invited to attend a future meeting of this Committee to answer Members' questions on the East of England Plan.</p> <p>(3) That a press release be issued outlining the Council's response to the consultation on the East of England Plan, which should emphasise that the Council decision was a unanimous, cross-party decision. (HPT)</p>
Report on the Representations Received During the Regulation 25 Consultation Process (Minute 37/07)	<p>That the Planning Policy Sub-Committee considers the representations and draft Regulation 26 Core Strategy document and makes appropriate recommendations to the Planning Policy and Transportation Committee in March 2007. (HPT)</p>
Joint Action Area Plan – Land West of Rochford (Minute 38/07)	<p>(1) That the Rochford Local Development Scheme be amended to include the timetable for the preparation of a Joint Acton Area Plan with Southend on Sea Borough Council to cover the area shown on the plan in Appendix One to the report.</p>

- (2) That the preparation of a shared economic strategy for the airport and Aviation Way Industrial Estate be agreed.
- (3) That the governance arrangements for the preparation of the Joint Action Area Plan and Economic Strategy be agreed, as outlined in the report. (HPT)

Unadopted Roads in Hullbridge (Minute 39/07)

That support be given to Hullbridge Parish Council to conduct a survey of residents, at no cost to the District Council, on whether or not to bring unadopted roads in Hullbridge up to an adoptable standard and to advise the District Council of the results. (HPT)

Update on Gypsy and Traveller Sites (Minute 40/07)

- (1) That, subject to a successful prosecution, direct action be taken in respect of site 3.
- (2) That, subject to a successful prosecution and the site not being vacated, details of the circumstances of the occupants be reported to Members to enable proper consideration to be given to the most appropriate form of action to resolve the breach in respect of site 7.
- (3) That a press release be issued when a site is successfully cleared. (HPT)

The above decisions will come into force, and may then be implemented, on the expiry of five working days after the publication of this Notice, unless referred to Full Council by a minimum of three Members or called in by the Review Committee.
