

## **NOTICE OF EXECUTIVE DECISIONS**

The Executive made the following decisions at its meeting on 21 October 2009:-

<b><u>Item</u></b>	<b><u>Decision</u></b>
<b>Bulky Household Waste Collection Service – Evaluation</b> (Minute 250/09)	(1) That the charging regime for bulky waste be retained and that concessions should not be introduced at this time.  (2) That the ‘no refund policy’ is endorsed together with the introduction of a voucher scheme in the situation where a service request is made and the item in question is removed prior to the Council’s contractor attending the premises. The request for a voucher shall be initiated by the customer and the voucher must be redeemed within 18 months.  (3) That officers further investigate with the Police, the Environment Agency and Parish/Town Councils the recent spate of thefts of items awaiting collection by the Council’s contractor. (HES)
<b>Performance Report on Key Projects for the period July to September 2009</b> (Minute 251/09)	That the progress against key projects for the second quarter of 2009/10 be noted. (HFAPM)
<b>Economic Development Strategy</b> (Minute 252/09)	That the Economic Development Strategy 2009 – 2014 attached at Appendix 1 of the report be adopted. (CPPM)

<b><u>Item</u></b>	<b><u>Decision</u></b>
<b>Council Support of the Voluntary Sector</b> (Minute 253/09)	That a Council Employee Support Programme for the voluntary sector on the lines outlined in the appendix to the report be implemented with effect from 1 April 2010. (CE)
<b>Media Protocol</b> (Minute 254/09)	That the revised and updated Media Protocol, as attached at Appendix A of the report, be approved. (HICS)

The above decisions will come into force, and may then be implemented, on the expiry of five working days after the publication of this Notice, unless referred to Full Council by a minimum of three Members or called in by the Review Committee.
