20/08 (Minute 201/08)	Facility for residents to pay for an additional bin under the new waste management contract	<p>Residents are settling into the new collection scheme. The new three bin system has increased capacity for each household by 165 litres, over 30% more waste can be disposed than previously. The service will be reviewed after 3 months to deal with any issues such as increasing capacity.</p> <p>In February this year, following consideration by the Council's Executive Board, it was agreed that the following criteria would be used as the basis for assessing requests for a second wheeled bin for residual waste to be provided free of charge:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Households must have 6 or more residents (discretion for children in nappies or specific medical needs). <p>The Executive Board also agreed that an additional residual waste bin or green recycling bin could be provided to residents upon request, providing that the residents pay the total purchase and service costs of the additional bins.</p> <p>The purchase and service cost of bins has yet to be fully assessed, although the addition fee required by the Council's contractor for emptying a residual bin is £365.30p per year. To this we would need to add the purchase price, the disposal costs and an administration fee.</p> <p>With regard to additional bins for dry recycling materials, it was agreed that individual cases should be considered on their merits. There are, however, financial implications related to this issue that need to be considered as part of the 2009/10 budget process.</p>	R Evans Rochford District Council 01702 318044
