NATIONAL DOMESTIC RATES – WRITE OFFS

1 SUMMARY

1.1 This report seeks Member approval to write off three National Non Domestic Rate debts in excess of £15,000 each.

2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Since the current Financial Regulations were introduced in January 2003, only debts in excess of £15,000 require formal Committee approval for write off.
- 2.2 This is the first report to be brought before Members since the implementation of the revised Financial Regulations. Four debts are shown at Appendix 1 of this report. These write offs will be charged against the National Non Domestic Rate Pool.
- 2.3 The four amounts total £92,736.75. This sum, covering a period of nearly three years, represents 0.8% of the total amount of £11.4m collectable and payable to the Government this financial year.

3 RECOMMENDATION

3.1 It is proposed that the Committee **RESOLVES**

To write off the debts shown at Appendix 1 of this report against the National Non Domestic Rate Pool.
