

BEST VALUE REVIEW ACTION PLAN – PUBLIC REGULATION, INSPECTION AND PROTECTION

1 SUMMARY

- 1.1 To update Members on progress to date with implementation of this action plan.

2 REVIEW ACTION PLAN

- 2.1 The final report of the Best Value Review of Public Regulation, Inspection and Protection, which was considered at the Environment Overview & Scrutiny Committee meeting on 3 December 2003 included a draft action plan. This has been updated to reflect the decisions taken at that meeting and subsequently through the budget process, and progress with implementation over the last six months.
- 2.2 The updated action plan is appended to this report. It is intended that further updates will be brought to this Committee at approximately six monthly intervals.
