

## **NOTICE OF EXECUTIVE DECISION**

The Executive made the following decision at its meeting on 19 October 2011:-

<b><u>Item</u></b>	<b><u>Decision</u></b>
<b>The Essex Works Commitment 2012-2017 Corporate Vision – Consultation Draft (Minute 244/11)</b>	<p>That the points outlined in paragraphs 3.1 and 3.2 of the Chief Executive's report, together with the following observations, be submitted as the Council's initial response to the County Council's draft Corporate Vision document:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• That the vision as outlined does not appear to effectively recognise and be well linked to the current reality. Thus, the overall value of the document is questionable</li><li>• That there is an absence of reference to District/Borough Councils as partners and their potential inclusion in any County Council decentralisation activity.</li><li>• That, given the economic situation, unless funding sources are clear, the specific highlighting of commitments such as enhancing the transport network within a five year time frame could be problematical. (CE)</li></ul>

The above decision will come into force, and may then be implemented, on the expiry of five working days after the publication of this Notice, unless referred to Full Council by a minimum of three Members or called in by the Review Committee.
