# ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL GOLDEN JUBILEE BOOKLET

#### 1 SUMMARY

- 1.1 Essex County Council is producing a 32 page colour Golden Jubilee booklet to commemorate the two Elizabeths and to reflect on the transformation of Essex over the past 50 years.
- 1.2 The book will be issued to all primary school children in the County, and some will be available for sale to the public.

#### 2 DETAILED CONSIDERATIONS

- 2.1 Correspondence has been received from Essex County Council asking if the Council along with all the other Districts in the County, would like to contribute towards the production of the booklet.
- 2.2 To date, Chelmsford and Colchester have indicated that they are prepared to contribute to the cost of the publication. Chelmsford has indicated a figure of £5000. Colchester has not yet determined the amount of its contribution.
- 2.3 Any contribution would be purely on a voluntary basis. Any District who contributes will be acknowledged in the publication.

### 3 OFFICER COMMENT

- 3.1 There are 3,300 Primary School children in the District who will receive a copy of the publication.
- 3.2 Members are asked to determine whether they wish to contribute towards the cost of this County-wide publication. There is no specific monies allocated for such a project in the Council's agreed budget.
- 3.3 The publication will proceed without any contribution from Rochford District Council.

#### 4 RECOMMENDATION

It is proposed that Committee **RESOLVES** not to make a contribution to the Essex County Council Golden Jubilee Booklet. (CEx)
