8 Overall Work Programme

Constitutionally, the Review Committee is responsible for setting its own work programme and, in so doing, taking into account the wishes of Members of the Committee.

The Review Committee should also respond, as soon as its work programme permits, to requests from the Council and, if it considers appropriate, Executive Board and Area Committees, to review particular areas of Council activity.

The Council's priorities for the coming year were set out and approved in the Chief Executive's report to Full Council on 27 February 2007, when specific consideration was given to issues that might be appropriate for examination by the Review Committee. The Council agreed that the Review Committee be asked to consider undertaking a review of the following issues:-

- 1) Understanding of Planning Appeal Procedures and the effectiveness of different forms of representation
- 2) Mental Health Services/Provision specifically with respect to the emerging new facility at Rochford
- 3) Operation of the New Political Decision Making Structure
- 4) Implications of Global Warming agenda on Rochford District and the role the District Council and its communities might play

The Committee is invited to consider the rest of its work programme.
