ROAD SAFETY - SCHOOL/PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

1 SUMMARY

1.1 The Finance & General Purposes Committee have allocated a budget of £30,000 to be spent on Road Safety – Schools and pedestrian crossings.

This report is to advise members how these funds could be spent effectively.

2 SUGGESTED SCHEMES

It is recommended that the funding be allocated to the following:

- £26,200 towards the provision of a Toucan crossing in Ashingdon Road near Holt Farm School; this will provide a safe crossing point near the school for pedestrians and cyclists. The remainder of the total sum for the toucan (approximately £25,000) will be funded by the county council as part of the package of measures presented to this committee on 25 January 2001 (Min 27/01)
- (b) £3,800 to fund provision of flashing amber warning signs outside Canewdon School. These have been requested by Canewdon Parish Council and the school.

In a survey of safe routes to school Canewdon School came third in order of priorities behind Stambridge and Barling Magna – both of which have had similar measures installed.

In both cases, it is expected that the works would be carried out in the 2001/2002 financial year.

2 RECOMMENDATION

That the £30,000 budget allocated to Road Safety – School/Pedestrian crossings be allocated as follows

- (1) £26,200 as part funding for a Toucan (cycles/pedestrians) crossing outside Holt Farm School.
- (b) £3,800 to the provision of flooding amber warning signs outside Canewdon School.
