| Schedule Item 1 | Officers recommend the following extra Condition: <br> SC20 PD RESTRICTED - DORMERS \& ROOF ALTERATIONS <br> Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 3, Schedule 2, Part 1, Class B and/or Class C, of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 (including any Order revoking or re-enacting that Order, with or without modification) no dormer windows, roof extension, roof light and/or window shall be inserted, or otherwise erected, within the roof area (including roof void) in/on any elevation of the dwelling hereby permitted. <br> REASON: To enable the Local Planning Authority to retain adequate control over the approved fenestration, in the interests of maintaining the amenities of the occupiers of nearby residential properties. <br> The applicant has submitted a further statement in support of their application within which the following points were raised: <br> - The site is not within the boundary of the scheduled ancient monument. <br> - The site borders the Outer Bailey, which is not part of the ancient monument. <br> - The last Appeal Inspector did not consider issues raised by the National Trust as a reason for refusal. <br> - The proposed garden area would help preserve the Outer Bailey area. <br> - The comments of the National Trust were made following consultation with the local National Trust Committee. <br> - The National Trust did not have a copy of the location plan (applicant has sent). <br> - The applicant requested the Outer Bailey be sold to the National Trust to ensure preservation. <br> - The bungalow will be 30 m away from the ancient monument, further than other properties and could not detract from its setting. |
