<b>Progress on Decisions – Tendering Process for the Grounds Maintenance Contract (Minute 398/06)</b> (Minute 93/07)	That the terms of reference of the Waste Management & Recycling Sub-Committee be expanded to include overseeing the progress and development of the contract procurement process for grounds maintenance. (HCS)
<b>Update on Brainstorming Meeting of 17 January 2007 (Minute 97/07)</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>(1) That the staging of an appropriate annual event to celebrate St George's Day be agreed.</li><li>(2) That Essex County Council be approached with proposals for improved directional and brown tourism signage for key facilities in the District.</li><li>(3) That further research be undertaken into the other items mentioned in sections 4.1 and 4.3 of the report and a further report be produced on the outcomes from this research that prioritises which of the ideas are to be taken further.</li><li>(4) That officers explore the possibilities of external grants to fund additional human resource capacity. For example, a Heritage Officer. (HCS)</li></ol>

The above decisions will come into force, and may then be implemented, on the expiry of five working days after the publication of this Notice, unless referred to Full Council by a minimum of three Members or called in by the Review Committee.
