REPORT OF URGENT ACTION: Consultation – Application by Cory Environmental Ltd. to Discharge Trade Effluent in Storm Conditions from Barling Quarry into a Tributary of the Tidal River Roach

1 SUMMARY

1.2 This report advises Members of urgent action taken (Minute 254/00).

2 BACKGROUND

- 2.2 The Water Resources Act 1991 requires the Environment Agency (the Agency) to consult the Council on the above application. The reason for urgency was that a response was required by the 25th May 2001.
- 2.3 Cory Environmental Ltd applied to the Agency for a licence for the discharge of storm water from the existing mineral washing and silt lagoons and field drainage at Barling Quarry, Barling. This application was for consent to discharge a maximum in any one day of 2000m³ of effluent by way of overflow when the maximum height of the lagoons was reached.
- 2.4 The Agency advised that Cory Environmental Ltd had an existing consent to discharge up to 4,000 m³/day of effluent from their works as part of the quarrying process.
- 2.5 The current application was received following investigation by the Agency into a complaint alleging an illegal discharge from the overflow of the lagoons.
- 2.6 Following consultation with the Chairman, Group Leaders and the Ward Member a response was sent to the Environment Agency.
