Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982
Public Entertainment Licensing
The Anchor, 23 High Street, Great Wakering

I refer to your application dated 12th October 2001 for the grant of a public entertainment licence in respect of these premises.

I have received a 3 letters of objection to your application. Please find enclosed a copy of the letters.

In view of these objections, I am considering whether the application needs to be referred to a meeting of the Council's Leisure Sub-Committee, which comprises a Committee of elected Members. You and the objectors would be invited to attend this Meeting.

If you reach an agreement with the objectors you should advise me in writing as soon as possible, giving me the details of the agreement.

As the objections concern noise and disturbance, under the provisions of General Regulation 5.20 you must provide me with your written proposals for preventing noise nuisance to local residents. These could include: keeping the windows and doors closed; limiting the level of music played in the premises so that it is not audible beyond the boundary of your premises; installing a noise limiting device; restricting your application for an occasional licence for no more than 28 occasions per year; reducing the days you wish to provide the entertainment; reducing the extent of the licence from karaoke and live bands to karaoke and no more than 2 performers.
