ISSUES ARISING FROM COMMUNITY OVERVIEW & SCRUTINY COMMITTEE – 17 SEPTEMBER 2002

1 LEISURE CONTRACT – HOLMES PLACE (Minute 425/02)

- 1.1 This item of business was referred by the Community Overview & Scrutiny Committee on 17 September to this Committee, with the recommendation that an option for a district wide leisure card scheme be adopted as detailed in paragraph 4.2 of Appendix 1 to this report.
- 1.2 Members of the Community Overview & Scrutiny Committee noted the various options that existed for the introduction of a Rochford Leisure Card scheme and favoured the option which would provide a financial benefit to residents.
- 1.3 It is proposed that the Community Services Committee **RESOLVES**

That the option for a district wide leisure card scheme, with no addition to the unitary charge, be adopted as follows:-

Residents would pay a lower initial joining fee than non-residents based on a 25% reduction. They would then pay on each visit the current members' rates which would be available to both resident and non-resident members. (CD(F&ES))

2 FALLS COLLABORATIVE (Minute 429/02)

- 2.1 This item of business was referred by the Community Overview & Scrutiny Committee on 17 September with the recommendation that the falls collaborative be supported and that a contribution of £2000 be made from the Housing Revenue Account. A copy of the Officer's report is attached at Appendix 2.
- 2.2 Members agreed that this is an admirable scheme, which they noted was aimed at reducing falls in older people by up to 30%.
- 2.3 It is proposed that the Community Services Committee **RESOLVES**

That the falls collaborative be supported and that a contribution of $\pounds 2000$ be made from the Housing Revenue Account. (HHHCC)
