

LEISURE CONSULTANCY (Min 15 Community Services Urgency Sub Committee)

1 SUMMARY

- 1.1. Leisure Consultants were recently appointed by the Council to explore a number of possible options for the future delivery of leisure in the District. Members are reminded that provision of leisure is a discretionary service.
- 1.2. The appended paper details the process the consultants wish to follow when undertaking public consultation as part of the options review. Representatives from PMP Consultancy will be present at the meeting to present the paper and discuss the options in more detail.
