1 PROPOSED EXTINGUISHMENT OF PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH 5, ASHINGDON

1.1 The Committee considered the report of the Head of Legal Services (appended) on an application for the extinguishment of a section of public footpath 5, Ashingdon.

- (2) That the Head of Legal Services be authorised to take all necessary steps to secure the making and confirmation of a Public Footpath Extinguishment Order under the terms of Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980. (HLS)
