**REPORT OF THE ENVIRONMENT OVERVIEW & SCRUTINY  
COMMITTEE – 18 NOVEMBER 2003**

**1 ASSESSMENT OF ODOUR EMISSIONS FROM THE STAMBRIDGE  
SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS**

1.1 This item of business was referred by the Environment Overview & Scrutiny Committee on 18 November to this Committee with the recommendation that monies be made available from virements within the 2003/2004 estimates for the provision of an independent odour survey and that the NHS be asked whether they might consider nominating a representative for the working group being established by Anglian Water. This was in response to various concerns raised by Members in relation to the treatment works. A copy of the officer's report is attached as Appendix A.

1.2 It is proposed that the Committee **RESOLVES**

- (1) That expenditure of up to £10,000 for the provision of an independent odour survey be made available from virements within the 2003/04 estimates.
- (2) That officers approach the NHS on the possibility of their nominating an appointee to the working group being established by Anglian Water. (HHHCC)
