1 MAGNOLIA ROAD, HAWKWELL – REPORT ON CURRENT SITUATION

1.1 This item of business was referred by the Environment Overview & Scrutiny Committee on 17 June to this Committee with the recommendation that no action be taken by the Highway Authority to restrict vehicular movements in Magnolia Road as it is a private street. This was as a result of an informal consultation on the various options for Magnolia Road proving inconclusive, with no unanimous support for any of the options. A copy of the Officer's report is attached as Appendix A.

1.2 It is proposed that the Committee **RESOLVES**

That no action be taken by the Highway Authority to restrict vehicular movements in Magnolia Road as it is a private street. (County Highways)

2 SERAS 2

- 2.1 This item of business was referred by the Environment Overview & Scrutiny Committee on 17 June to this Committee with the recommendation that no further comment be made by this Council with respect to the SERAS 2 consultation and that this Council offers support to Huntingdonshire District Council in objecting to any airport development at Alconbury. The Committee considered that there did not appear to be any significant differences between the Alconbury and Southend Airport facilities. A copy of the Officer's report is attached as Appendix B.
- 2.2 It is proposed that the Committee **RESOLVES**
 - (1) That no further comment be made with respect to the SERAS 2 consultation.
 - (2) That this Council offers support to Huntingdonshire District Council in objecting to any airport development at Alconbury. (HPS)

3 VILLAGE AND TOWN CENTRE REGENERATION SCHEMES

3.1 This item of business was referred by the Environment Overview & Scrutiny Committee on 17 June to this Committee with the recommendation that the schemes at Hullbridge and Hockley are completed and that up to £5,000 be allocated from within the capital programme to achieve this. To address concerns about the increase in estimated costs for the schemes, further

reports detailing sources of income and expenditure for the schemes and proposing ways of financially monitoring Essex County contracts will be considered at the next meeting of the Environment Overview & Scrutiny Committee. A copy of the Officer's report is attached as Appendix C.

3.2 It is proposed that the Committee **RESOLVES**

That the schemes at Hullbridge and Hockley are completed and that up to $\pm 5,000$ be allocated from within the capital programme to achieve this. (CD(F&ES))
