1 WEBSTERS WAY – ENVIRONMENTAL ENHANCEMENT

1.1 This item of business was referred by the Environment Overview & Scrutiny Committee on 21 January to this Committee with the recommendation that no further action be taken on the proposals for the environmental enhancement of Websters Way, Raleigh without financial support from Rayleigh Town Council and Essex County Council.
