# STAMBRIDGE SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS LIAISON COMMITTEE

### 1 SUMMARY

1.1 To appoint three Member representatives to attend the Stambridge Sewage Treatment Works Liaison Committee for the Municipal Year.

### 2 LIAISON COMMITTEE

- 2.1 The Committee was established several years ago as a result of the developments at Stambridge Sewage Treatment Works, and has continued to meet several times each year as an informal forum for the exchange of information.
- 2.2 Representatives from Stambridge Parish Council, "Sludgewatch" the local action group, Essex County Council and Anglian Water attend, as well as this Council's Member representatives. On occasions the Member of Parliament has attended.
- 2.3 The Committee is currently chaired by the Development Control Manager, Essex County Council, and the secretariat provided by Stambridge Parish Council.

- 3.2 An Officer sometimes attends the meetings, which may give rise to compensatory time off in lieu.
