Minute no 58	<p>Review of the Operation of the Planning Enforcement Service</p> <p>Following the meeting of the Review Committee on the 12 February it was agreed that an update in respect of the following two items would be provided:-</p> <p>(1) Recommendation to the former Planning Policy & Transportation Committee that the Head of Planning and Transportation conducts an annual review of outstanding enforcement cases, with the Development Control Committee to confirm those cases to be closed.</p> <p>(2) Recommendation to the former Planning Policy & Transportation Committee that the Head of Planning and Transportation reviews the provision of duty cover in order that those members of the enforcement</p>	<p>A review is now nearing completion. Since 1 June 2007, 167 cases have been closed – of that total 30 have been closed as a result of the review (of all cases more than a year old), with a further 6 cases identified that are likely to be closed.</p> <p>The review of the provision of duty officer cover is nearing completion – a full report will be presented to a meeting of the Executive Board in April 2008.</p>
