Motion on Notice	(1) That Essex Police be requested to provide appropriate traffic warden cover to Rochford Town Centre to deal with the inconsiderate car parking situation, and invited to a meeting of the Environment Overview and Scrutiny Committee to discuss their proposals.
	(2) That, given their increased officer resource and the fact that decriminalised parking enforcement is not due to be introduced in Rochford until October 2004, a letter be sent to Essex Police requesting that additional police presence be introduced at Rochford Town Centre to help address parking problems. (HRHM)
Outstanding Issues – Stambridge Sewage Treatment Works Progress Report	That this Committee wishes to place on record its extreme displeasure at the way Anglian Water responds to problems associated with the Stambridge Sewage Treatment Works. (HHHCC)
Contaminated Land – Update	That the progress of implementation of the Contaminated Land Strategy and the funding proposals be noted. (HHHCC)
Historic Settlement Assessment Reports	That the preparation of Historic Settlement Assessment Reports for Ashingdon (the historic core around the church), Great Wakering and Paglesham, as outlined in the report of the Head of Planning Services, be commissioned. (HPS)

Travel Accessibility and Developer Contributions

That the approach prepared by the Essex Planning Officers Association for dealing with Travel Accessibility and Developer Contributions merits support and that further consideration be given to adopting the methodology as Supplementary Planning Guidance when the results of the consultation exercise have been analysed and reported back. (HPS)

Town Centre Enhancement Schemes - Funding arrangements

- (1) That £15,000 of the £100,000 made available for the enhancement of Rochford Town Centre be allocated to the creation of a new access (in-only) to the Rochford Back Lane car Park at the end of Locks Hill, with the existing entrance becoming an exit only into Back Lane.
- (2) That the remaining £85,000, together with any underspend from Rochford, be reallocated to the enhancement schemes in Hullbridge and Hockley, with up to £25,000 being used to construct phase 2 of the Hullbridge scheme and £60,000, plus any unused funds from Hullbridge, being utilised for the Hockley scheme.
- (3) That the Area Manager, County Highways, report back to this Council on the outcome of the current investigation into the various concerns associated with Contract 2000 as they relate to the Town Centre Enhancement Schemes within the District. (HPS)

The above decisions will come into force, and may then be implemented, on the expiry of five working days after the date of this Notice, unless called in by an Overview and Scrutiny Committee or any three Members of the Council.
