### ANNUAL VANDALISM REPORT

#### 1 SUMMARY

- 1.1 This report provides Members with information regarding the cost of vandalism to council property throughout the District, covering the period 1 October 2002 to 30 September 2003.
- 1.2 There is increased detail provided in this report to give a clearer picture of the types and levels of vandalism in the District.

#### 2 INTRODUCTION

- 2.1 Repairs and maintenance, necessary as a result of vandalism or criminal damage, are recorded on Contracted Services works orders database. It is possible to interrogate the computer system to provide a list of such orders within a given period.
- 2.2 The maintenance of the leisure buildings became the responsibility of Holmes Place from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2002. Holmes Place have provided actual costs for repairs caused through vandalism for the report period.
- 2.3 Maintenance of the playspaces on a day to day basis is contained within the Grounds Maintenance Contract.

#### 3 VANDALISM INCIDENTS

3.1 This report has been expanded on previous years and broken into 4 areas: 1 Council Maintained Property, 2 Leisure Buildings, 3 Play Spaces, and 4 Recycling Banks.

## 3.2 Council Maintained Property

The attached schedule (appendix A) provides a detailed list of the sites and areas that have experienced vandalism for the period 1 October 2002 to 30 September 2003. Where no cost has been shown against a specific item, works were carried out by the Council's own internal staff.

The Council carried out works in 121 reported instances of vandalism. Of these works, the largest volumes were: 49% of damage to council housing at a cost of £3356, 27% of damage to pavilions at a cost of £1367, and 17% of damage to public conveniences at a cost of £3182. The other 7% was spread over other areas.

The types of damage were varied, although broken doors and windows featured largely on council housing, and graffiti made up 17% of the overall damage. Rochford and Rayleigh between them accounted for 74% of the damage.

### 3.3 **Leisure Buildings**

Holmes Place incurred significant cost due to vandalism at the buildings it maintains, at a total cost of £6596. A high percentage of damage was due to broken doors and windows, although The Mill encountered a number of graffiti incidents.

### 3.4 Play Spaces

As part of the grounds maintenance contract, all the play spaces in the District are inspected twice weekly. Serviceteam have provided detailed report sheets of damage due to vandalism. In these instances the depositing of broken glass within a playspace is considered as vandalism. These have been included in this report (see Appendix B).

### 3.5 **Recycling Banks**

The recycling team record information relating to contaminated paper bins and this has been included (see Appendix C). The items listed are primarily where bins have been set alight.

#### 4 RISK IMPLICATIONS

#### 4.1 Strategic Risk

Vandalism is a crime and disorder issue requiring actions through the Police, Community Safety Team, and with specific actions by the Council. Expansion of this report will allow a more detailed look at the problem areas.

#### 4.2 Resource Risk

The cost of vandalism to Council maintained property is met from revenue budgets and detracts from carrying out more positive actions. Some of this risk is managed through the provision of leisure activities in School holiday sports and arts schemes.

#### 4.3 **Operational Risk**

Vandalism to public conveniences leads to short term closure and loss of service. Vandalism in Public Conveniences is being tackled through the

installation of self closing doors which reduce the opportunity for vandals to enter at night.

Damage to play spaces poses a significant health and safety risk to young children. It is clear the frequent inspection of playspaces is proving to be a positive management of this risk as there are very few reported incidents in these areas.

#### 4.4 Reputation Risk

Rochford District Council sets out to provide high quality services, these incidents of vandalism detract from this aim and can impact on the reputation of the Council.

### 4.5 **Third Party Risk**

Vandalism often poses a third party risk due to injury and, therefore, has to be dealt with as a matter of urgency where risks are identified.

#### 5 CRIME AND DISORDER IMPLICATIONS

- 5.1 Vandalism is primarily a crime and disorder issue that needs concerted joint action with the Police to tackle and reduce. A more detailed analysis of the incidents will help to identify problem areas and possible solutions, although given the fairly random incidence of vandalism single action will not have a significant effect on the problem.
- 5.2 Incidents of vandalism are not reported to the Police unless the opportunity arises to identify the perpetrator and a chance of prosecution is likely.
- 5.3 The opportunity of using the information in this report will be taken to see whether the Crime and Disorder strategy can be used to impact on the problem.

#### 6 ENVIRONMENTAL IMPLICATIONS

6.1 Vandalism has the potential to reduce the quality of life for Rochford District residents.

#### 7 RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

7.1 The total cost of £8222, due to vandalism on Council maintained property, is met from various revenue budgets. Staff resources are also used to carry out some of the minor works. Given the actual level of expenditure there will need to be careful management of any measures to ensure that costs do not exceed potential benefits.

- 7.2 Holmes Place have incurred costs of £6,596 to deal with vandalism in the leisure buildings. Serviceteam costs to maintain playspaces are included within the grounds maintenance contract. Both Holmes Place and Serviceteam have allocated significant resources to maintain their respective areas to a high standard.
- 7.3 The Council receives income for the paper recycling. Loss of income is incurred due to the contents becoming contaminated, such as burnt. The contract with the company providing the recycling bins allows for replacement, due to the bins being set alight, twice only, the Council is then required to pay for replacement.

#### 8 PARISH IMPLICATIONS

8.1 The reports indicate that incidents of vandalism are not concentrated in any particular Parish area. Vandalism tends to be worse in built up areas.

#### 9 RECOMMENDATION

- 9.1 It is proposed that the Committee **RESOLVES** 
  - (1) To note the cost of vandalism to the District Council.
  - (2) To develop a specific action plan with Police support to combat this vandalism, including the targetting of schools and clubs as part of an educational campaign.
