

Listed below is the prioritised list of Localism schemes recommended by the East Area Committee on 28 January 2010 to Essex County Council for delivery during 1010/11:-

| Scheme/Description | Estimated Cost | Order of preference 1-4 where 1 is highest priority |

| Barling Road, Barling (in the vicinity of the school) – pedestrian crossing | £15,000 | 1 |
| High Street, Great Wakering – pedestrian crossing | £15,000 | 3 |
| Canewdon Road, Ashingdon – provide footway | | 3 |
| Stambridge Road, Great Stambridge – widen existing footway from school towards Rochford | Not costed but would be over £50,000 | 1 |
| High Street, Canewdon – footway to link village school and shop | £7,500 plus cost of land (unknown at present) | 2 |
| Poynters Lane, Great Wakering – provide footway from Cupids Chase to Wakering Road | CIF bid has been made, yet to be determined | 2 |
| Twyford Avenue, Great Wakering – protection of verge to prevent parking abuse | £3,000 - £10,000 | 2 |
