The application for the above Licence has now been reviewed. Environmental Health now wishes to withdraw our representation. The applicant has agreed (confirmed by an e-mail dated 9th March 2021) to the conditions listed below to be included on the premises licence, the Pavement Permission, and in addition the condition offered and put forward by the applicant in respect of the live music deregulation under his conditions to promote the licensing objective of Prevention of Public nuisance.

1. The internal ceiling and flanking to be sound proofed against internally generated noise, in accordance with a scheme to be submitted to and agreed in writing with the local Planning Authority. Such agreed works shall be fully implemented prior to the commencement of any use hereby permitted and shall be maintained in the approved form while the premises are in use for the permitted purpose.
2. External doors and windows to be kept closed except for the door opening and closing to allow people to enter and leave the premises.
3. Display and maintain signs at the exits of the building that a dedicated smoking area is provided at the rear of the premises.
4. Smoking should only take place in the dedicated smoking area at the rear of the premises.
5. Provide and maintain ashtrays/cigarette Stubbers at the entrance to the premises and also in the smoking area.
6. Display and maintain signs at exits and all external areas controlled by the premises asking customers to respect neighbouring premises with regards to noise and acceptable behaviour.
7. Staff to monitor the external smoking area on a regular (hourly) basis to ensure that customers are not causing a public nuisance.

8. Bottles/Glass bins shall **NOT** be emptied between the hours of 8pm and 10am Monday to Friday and **NOT** between the hours of 8pm & 11am on Sat, Sunday and bank Holidays.
9. Customers will not be permitted to remove from the premises any alcoholic drinks supplied by the premises in open containers, with exception to drinks provided by the premises to customers seated at tables within an area permitted to be used by the premises via a current/valid pavement permission permit.

In respect of the pavement permission condition:

1. Operating hours 12midday until 8pm Monday to Sunday.

The applicant has volunteered the following as his own condition to be included with the ones put forward by Environmental Health.

The premises will not benefit from Section 177 of the Licensing Act 2003 in respect of Live music, instead Live music will only be provided Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays, between 12midday until 8pm.

Live music and Recorded music to be provided as ambient background music, with live music being unamplified acoustic sets only.
