ANNUAL VANDALISM REPORT

1 SUMMARY

1.1 This report provides Members with information regarding the cost of vandalism to council property throughout the District covering the 12 month period 1 October 2001 to 30 September 2002.

2 INTRODUCTION

- 2.1 Repairs and maintenance necessary as a result of vandalism or criminal damage are recorded on the works orders raised by Contracted Services. It is possible to interrogate the computer system to provide a list of such orders within a given period.
- 2.2 From 1 April 2002, the maintenance of the leisure buildings became the responsibility of Holmes Place. Holmes Place have provided approximate costs incurred to rectify the vandalism that has occurred since they took over the management of the leisure contract. It is hoped that more detailed information will be supplied in future.

3 VANDALISM REPORT

- 3.1 The attached schedule (appendix A) provides a detailed list of the sites and areas that have experienced vandalism for the period 1 October 2001 to 30 September 2002. Where no cost has been shown against a specific item, the works were carried out by the internal workforce.
- 3.2 The Council carried out works in 51 reported instances of vandalism.

 Of these works, the largest cost was to replace 2 door entry systems at Rochford Garden Way where the locks were damaged beyond repair.

 The other areas of significant overall cost were incurred by Holmes Place to the leisure buildings.

4 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

4.1 The costs for these repairs have been met from the various provisions for responsive repairs and maintenance. As Members will see, the total cost of vandalism experienced by the Council, including Holmes Place where the latter has taken over control of the Council's leisure buildings, is £11834.15 over the 12 months period.

5 CRIME AND DISORDER IMPLICATIONS

- 5.1 Whilst the largest number of instances of vandalism have taken place in the Rochford area, vandalism has generally been evenly spread across the period and the district; no particular area or time of year stands out as needing targeting to reduce vandalism.
- 5.2 The public conveniences in the district have attracted approximately 29% of all the vandalism, this element will have been discussed as part of the "condition of public conveniences" report at Community Overview and Scrutiny Committee 15 October 2002.

6 RECOMMENDATION
