	(3)	That regular monitoring be undertaken of the Council's waste management and recycling forward plan, by means of 6-weekly meetings of the Waste Management & Recycling Sub-Committee, as required, with measurement against statutory targets, and that this be one of the key headline performance monitoring issues for the Policy, Finance & Strategic Performance Committee.
	(4)	That no changes be made with respect to collections of second wheeled bins and that the Waste Management & Recycling Sub-Committee consider the issue of introducing a charge for second wheeled bin collections. (CD(ES))
The above decisions will come into force, and may then be implemented, on the expiry of five working days after the publication of this Notice, unless referred to Full Council by a minimum of three Members or called in by an Overview and Scrutiny Committee.
