# POST OFFICE CLOSURES IN ROCHFORD DISTRICT COUNCIL AREA

#### 1 SUMMARY

1.1 This report seeks Members' views on proposals outlined by the Post Office in respect of the Post Office branch network in the District.

# 2 INTRODUCTION

2.1 The Post Office have undertaken a comprehensive review of the 15 Post Office branches in the Rayleigh constituency part of the District. As a result of this review, they have reached the conclusion that they can continue to provide the current level of service with fewer branches. They have now contacted the District Council, along with other bodies in the area, outlining their proposals with a view to requiring responses by the 9<sup>th</sup> of December.

#### 3 DETAILED CONSIDERATIONS

- 3.1 Following a comprehensive review of the 15 Post Office branches in the Rayleigh constituency area, the Post Office believe that there are too many branches competing to serve both the existing and forecast customer base. In agreement with the sub Post Masters concerned, they are proposing to permanently close two out of a total of 15 branches in the area and expressed confidence that the remaining 13 branches have the capacity to cope with the increase in customers expected to migrate from the branches identified for closure.
- 3.2 In reaching their conclusions, the Post Office state that they have carried out a detailed review of every branch. They have also considered aspects such as the availability of public transport, parking facilities, topography and ease of pedestrian access to the branches themselves.
- 3.3 The two branches the Post Office is proposing to close are:

Apex Corner 127 Plumberow Avenue Hockley

Golden Cross 279 Ashingdon Road Rochford

Appendix 1 outlines details of the alternative branches which would cover these closures.

# COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMITTEE – 2 December 2003

- 3.4 With the Post Office requiring responses to their proposals no later than the 9<sup>th</sup> of December, Members are now asked to consider whether they wish to raise any objections to these proposals or comments on their implementation together with the reasoning behind any response.
- 3.5 From an officer view point, the Head of Revenue and Housing Management has expressed some concerns regarding closures as the Rent Collection System relies on swipe cards. This was a system introduced only two years ago and developed jointly with Post Office Counters Ltd. Around 700 tenants use this facility on a weekly basis for payment of housing and garage rents. Fortunately, the Post Offices proposed for closure serve only relatively few tenants. These tenants will need to find alternative methods of payment, e.g. Internet or telephone payment facilities.

# 4 PARISH IMPLICATIONS

4.1 The relevant Parishes will undoubtedly be considering these closures and determining their responses to the proposals as outlined.

# 5 RECOMMENDATION

5.1 It is proposed that the Committee determine its views on the proposals as outlined in the report.
