GRANTS TO OUTSIDE BODIES – RAYLEIGH OPERATIC AND DRAMATIC SOCIETY (RODS) (Min 305/00)

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Members will recall that, at a meeting of this Sub Committee on 19 January 2000, it was agreed that, where grant applications had not been received prior to the published deadline, grants would not be considered.
- 1.2 RODS have received a grant for several years past and a form was sent to the Society in October 1999. However, no application was returned, and it appears that the contact address had changed.
- 1.3 Some information was outstanding from the Society from last year, namely what, if any, financial support had been received from other organisations.
- 1.4 A letter has now been received (attached at Appendix 1) giving some detail of other applications made, together with a completed application form, a summary of which is attached at Appendix 2.

2 CRITERIA

2.1 Members will see from Appendix 2 that RODS fall into category 2/3 which is :-

Provide a cost effective, community-focused service that complements the local authority's discretionary priorities.

- Rochford District Council's funding represents less than 50% of total funding
- 2.2 In previous years, when a cut-off point was set, the Society did not meet the criteria for the approval of a grant, although grants were made. Although the Society emphasises its youth work in this year's application, its general objectives appear unchanged.

3 RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The grants budget for the current year is exhausted. Should this grant be approved, a virement would be required from another budget head.

4 RECOMMENDATION
