#### 91 MINUTES

The Minutes of the meeting held on 11 December 2001 were approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

## 92 STANDARDS COMMITTEE – RECRUITMENT OF INDEPENDENT AND PARISH REPRESENTATIVES

The Sub-Committee considered the report of the Chief Executive on the appointment of Independent and Parish Representatives to the Standards Committee.

#### (i) Independent Members

In discussing proposals for the recruitment of Independent Members, the Sub-Committee noted that appointees must not have been a Councillor for a period of 5 years preceding appointment to a Standards Committee.

The Sub-Committee agreed a motion moved by Councillor P F A Webster and seconded by Councillor D R Helson adjusting a paragraph of the proposed person specification.

### **RECOMMENDED**

(1) That authority be delegated to the Chief Executive to appoint two Independent Members to the Standards Committee via

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- public advertisement, the appointments to be made on a 4 year basis to tie in with the District Council's Electoral Cycle.
- (2) That paragraph (ii) of the Person Specification be revised to indicate that applicants will need to live in the District and have a good knowledge of its communities.(CE)

### (ii) Parish Members

Responding to Member questions, Officers advised that:-

- It was not anticipated that the Standards Committee would meet very often.
- The appointed representative would be given training and any problems could be addressed as they arise.
- In Chairing the proposed meeting of Town/Parish Councils, in the case of a tie in the vote, the District would have the casting vote.

#### **RECOMMENDED**

- (1) That the District Council convene and Chair a meeting of all the Town/Parish Councils to determine a suitable Parish/Town Council nomination to the Standards Committee. Councils to be asked to forward suitable candidates for consideration in advance of the meeting. Each Parish to be afforded a single vote with the successful candidate being appointed as the Parish/Town Councils representative.
- (2) That, given the differing election cycles of the various Town/Parish Councils, the appointment be on a yearly basis running in tandem with the Municipal Year. (CE)

#### (iii) Model Code of Conduct – Advertisement

The Corporate Director (Law, Planning and Administration) referred the Sub-Committee to a requirement that District and Town/Parish Councils place press advertisements relating to adoption of the new Model Code of Conduct. Members endorsed the proposal of the Corporate Director that liaison be undertaken with Parish/Town Councils with a view to a sharing of the associated costs.

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### **RECOMMENDED**

That Officers liaise with the Town/Parish Councils with a view to a sharing of the costs associated with the press advertisement relating to the new Code of Conduct. (CD(LP&A))

### 93 PUBLIC ACCESS TO WORKING GROUPS

The Sub-Committee considered the report of the Corporate Director (Law, Planning and Administration) on Working Group Protocol as it relates to public access.

#### **RECOMMENDED**

That, subject to the adjustment of paragraph 12 of Working Group Protocol to read as follows, the existing Working Group Protocol be confirmed:-

"Representatives of the media, other organisations and members of the public will not be admitted to meetings of Working Groups save where invited to attend by a majority of those District Council Members of the Group that may be present at the meeting concerned". (HAMS)
