SKATEBOARDING EVENTS

1 SUMMARY

1.1 The purpose of this report is to apprise Members of the cost of providing skateboarding events in Rayleigh and Rochford around Easter 2003.

2 INTRODUCTION

2.1 At a meeting of the Community Overview and Scrutiny Committee on 14th November 2002, the report on Summer Holiday Activities highlighted the success of the skateboarding day held in the Market Car Park in Rayleigh on Monday 19th August which approximately 140 young people attended. Members requested that the possibility of providing skateboarding events in Rayleigh and Rochford around Easter 2003 be investigated and that a report is brought back to this Committee detailing the costs involved.

3 MOBILE SKATEPARKS

3.1 Two companies that provide mobile skateparks have been identified. The cheapest quotation is from the company involved in the skateboarding event held during the summer. A variety of equipment would be provided, including barriers to cordon-off the skatepark area and up to 20 sets of safety equipment. Rochford District Council staff and employees from the company supplying the equipment will provide supervision. In a response to some criticism from the summer events, only those children and young people wearing safety equipment will be allowed access to the ramps.

4 CRIME AND DISORDER IMPLICATIONS

4.1 It is widely recognised that involving children and young people in leisure pursuits reduces instances of youth nuisance and violence.

5 RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

- 5.1 The cost of providing a mobile skatepark for a day is estimated to be £780 + VAT. This is for provision free of charge. It is also estimated that approximately £50 will be lost in parking fees if the Market car Park in Rayleigh is used again. Discussions will be held with Holmes Place with a view to using the Freight House car park for the Rochford venue.
- 5.2 If a charge was made for the use of the skatepark, it is estimated that the cost of provision will be in the region of £400.

5.3 The cost will be met from existing funds.

RECOMMENDATION

6.1 It is proposed that the Committee considers and **recommends** whether or not skateboarding events should be held in Rayleigh and Rochford over the Easter period and whether or not a charge should be made for the event (CD(F&ES))
