REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD 416

Council considered the exempt report of the Executive Board on the award of contracts for waste management, street cleansing and grounds maintenance.

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Members joined with the Leader of the Council in recognising the notable and extensive work undertaken by the Chairman of the Contracts Sub-Committee, Cllr M G B Starke. Cllr Starke's contribution had been key to the development of contract proposals that would serve the community well in forthcoming years. Reference was also made to the sterling work of other members of the Contracts Sub-Committee and to the contribution of officers. Cllr M G B Starke paid personal tribute to the contributions of fellow Sub-Committee members and valuable officer support. It had also been good to have had an overview from the Chairman of the Council's Review Committee, Cllr Mrs J R Lumley.

In presenting the recommendations, Cllr M G B Starke emphasised the need for step change in levels of recycling and how proposals accorded with the requirements of residents. Recent waste analysis activity had been instructive in terms of the possibilities for the recycling of various materials and for step change.
