
ROCHFORD CRIME AND DISORDER REDUCTION STRATEGY 2002/05 - DRAFT

1 SUMMARY

- 1.1 To apprise Members of the new draft Rochford Crime and Disorder Reduction Strategy 2002/05 and seek Members' comments for the proposals outlined. ([Appendix 1](#)).

2 INTRODUCTION

- 2.1 In April 1999 Rochford District Council produced a crime and disorder strategy with its partnership agencies covering a three year time scale. This strategy will expire in April 2002 and, as a consequence a new strategy is being produced to cover the three years ending 2005.
- 2.2 As with the formation of the original strategy, an audit has been conducted and is currently being analysed. A draft strategy has been produced but is subject to alteration in relation to the final analysis of the audit.
- 2.3 Once this has been achieved the draft strategy will be reviewed by all the partnership agencies in preparation for its finalisation and agreement.

3 CRIME AND DISORDER IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 These are self evident from the contents of the draft strategy.

4 RESOURCE IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 There are a number of actions that will have resource implications.

5 LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

- 5.1 The production of a new Crime and Disorder Reduction Strategy for Rochford District by April 2002 is a statutory requirement in terms of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998.

6 PARISH IMPLICATIONS

- 6.1 These will depend on the final decision regarding priority areas for consideration.

7 RECOMMENDATION

7.1 It is proposed that the Sub-Committee **RECOMMENDS**

That the Council accepts the objectives, and actions within, in the new strategy prior to further consultation within the Crime and Disorder Partnership. (CEX)
